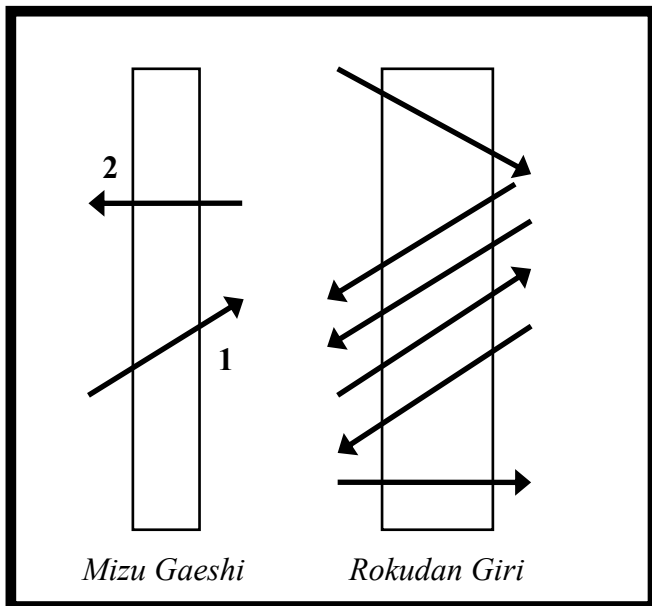


From *Kata*

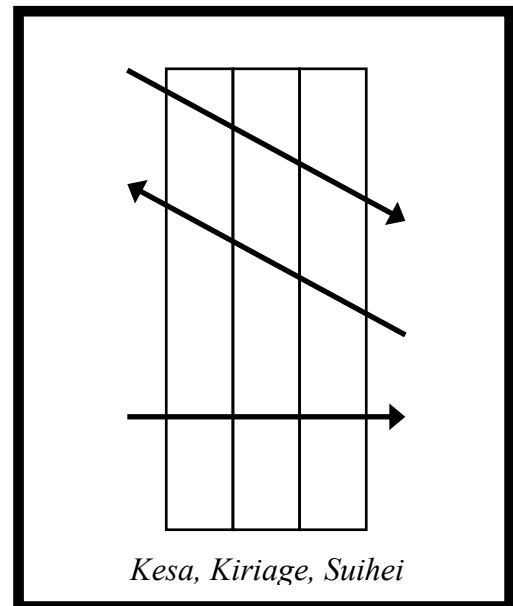
Final round is performed from a Japanese style *Kata*. Please announce the *Kata*.

- Please announce the *Kata*.

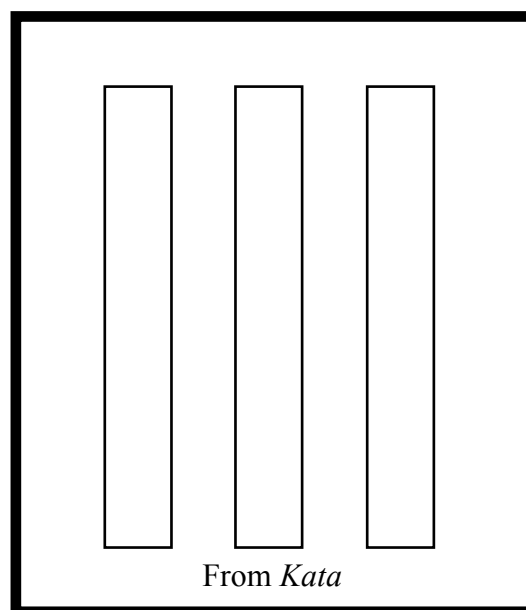

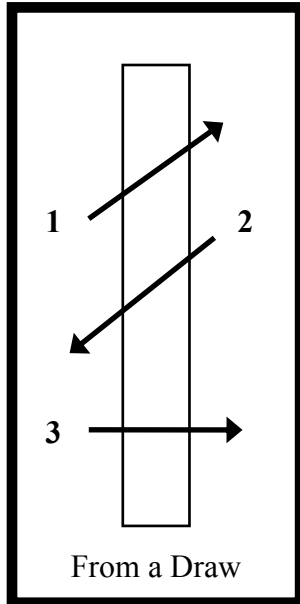

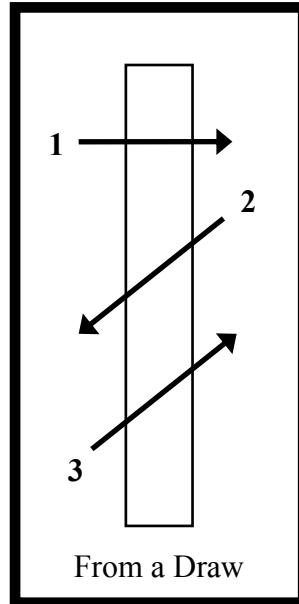
